

The Holy Spirit in the Gospels

Matthew 1:18 (NIV)

This is how the birth of Jesus Christ came about: His mother Mary was pledged to be married to Joseph, but before they came together, she was found to be with child through the Holy **Spirit**.

Matthew 1:20 (NIV)

But after he had considered this, an angel of the Lord appeared to him in a dream and said, "Joseph son of David, do not be afraid to take Mary home as your wife, because what is conceived in her is from the Holy **Spirit**."

Matthew 3:11 (NIV)

"I baptize you with water for repentance. But after me will come one who is more powerful than I, whose sandals I am not fit to carry. He will baptize you with the Holy **Spirit** and with fire."

Matthew 3:16 (NIV)

As soon as Jesus was baptized, he went up out of the water. At that moment heaven was opened, and he saw the **Spirit** of God descending like a dove and lighting on him.

Matthew 4:1 (NIV)

Then Jesus was led by the **Spirit** into the desert to be tempted by the devil.

Matthew 10:20 (NIV)

for it will not be you speaking, but the **Spirit** of your Father speaking through you.

Matthew 12:18 (NIV)

"Here is my servant whom I have chosen,
the one I love, in whom I delight;
I will put my **Spirit** on him,
and he will proclaim justice to the nations.

Matthew 12:28 (NIV)

But if I drive out demons by the **Spirit** of God, then the kingdom of God has come upon you.

Matthew 12:31-32 (NIV)

And so I tell you, every sin and blasphemy will be forgiven men, but the blasphemy against the **Spirit** will not be forgiven. ³²Anyone who speaks a word against the Son of Man will be forgiven, but anyone who speaks against the Holy **Spirit** will not be forgiven, either in this age or in the age to come.

Matthew 22:43 (NIV)

He said to them, "How is it then that David, speaking by the **Spirit**, calls him 'Lord'? For he says,

Matthew 28:19 (NIV)

Therefore go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy **Spirit**,

Mark 1:8 (NIV)

I baptize you with water, but he will baptize you with the Holy **Spirit**."

Mark 1:10 (NIV)

As Jesus was coming up out of the water, he saw heaven being torn open and the **Spirit** descending on him like a dove.

Mark 1:12 (NIV)

At once the **Spirit** sent him out into the desert,

Mark 3:29 (NIV)

But whoever blasphemes against the Holy **Spirit** will never be forgiven; he is guilty of an eternal sin."

Mark 12:36 (NIV)

David himself, speaking by the Holy **Spirit**, declared:

"The Lord said to my Lord:

"Sit at my right hand

until I put your enemies

under your feet." "

Mark 13:11 (NIV)

Whenever you are arrested and brought to trial, do not worry beforehand about what to say. Just say whatever is given you at the time, for it is not you speaking, but the Holy **Spirit**.

Luke 1:15 (NIV)

for he will be great in the sight of the Lord. He is never to take wine or other fermented drink, and he will be filled with the Holy **Spirit** even from birth.

Luke 1:35 (NIV)

The angel answered, "The Holy **Spirit** will come upon you, and the power of the Most High will overshadow you. So the holy one to be born will be called the Son of God.

Luke 1:41 (NIV)

When Elizabeth heard Mary's greeting, the baby leaped in her womb, and Elizabeth was filled with the Holy **Spirit**.

Luke 1:67 (NIV)

His father Zechariah was filled with the Holy **Spirit** and prophesied:

Luke 2:25-27 (NIV)

Now there was a man in Jerusalem called Simeon, who was righteous and devout. He was waiting for the consolation of Israel, and the Holy **Spirit** was upon him. ²⁶It had been revealed to him by the Holy **Spirit** that he would not die before he had seen the Lord's Christ. ²⁷Moved by the **Spirit**, he went into

the temple courts. When the parents brought in the child Jesus to do for him what the custom of the Law required,

Luke 3:16 (NIV)

John answered them all, "I baptize you with water. But one more powerful than I will come, the thongs of whose sandals I am not worthy to untie. He will baptize you with the Holy **Spirit** and with fire.

Luke 3:22 (NIV)

and the Holy **Spirit** descended on him in bodily form like a dove. And a voice came from heaven: "You are my Son, whom I love; with you I am well pleased."

Luke 4:1 (NIV)

Jesus, full of the Holy **Spirit**, returned from the Jordan and was led by the **Spirit** in the desert,

Luke 4:14 (NIV)

Jesus returned to Galilee in the power of the **Spirit**, and news about him spread through the whole countryside.

Luke 4:18 (NIV)

"The **Spirit** of the Lord is on me,
because he has anointed me
to preach good news to the poor.
He has sent me to proclaim freedom for the prisoners
and recovery of sight for the blind,
to release the oppressed,

Luke 10:21 (NIV)

At that time Jesus, full of joy through the Holy **Spirit**, said, "I praise you, Father, Lord of heaven and earth, because you have hidden these things from the wise and learned, and revealed them to little children. Yes, Father, for this was your good pleasure.

Luke 11:13 (NIV)

If you then, though you are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father in heaven give the Holy **Spirit** to those who ask him!"

Luke 12:10 (NIV)

And everyone who speaks a word against the Son of Man will be forgiven, but anyone who blasphemes against the Holy **Spirit** will not be forgiven.

Luke 12:12 (NIV)

for the Holy **Spirit** will teach you at that time what you should say."

John 1:32-33 (NIV)

Then John gave this testimony: "I saw the **Spirit** come down from heaven as a dove and remain on him. ³³I would not have known him, except that the one who sent me to baptize with water told me,

'The man on whom you see the **Spirit** come down and remain is he who will baptize with the Holy **Spirit**.'

John 3:5-6 (NIV)

Jesus answered, "I tell you the truth, no one can enter the kingdom of God unless he is born of water and the **Spirit**. ⁶Flesh gives birth to flesh, but the **Spirit** gives birth to **spirit**."

John 3:8 (NIV)

The wind blows wherever it pleases. You hear its sound, but you cannot tell where it comes from or where it is going. So it is with everyone born of the **Spirit**."

John 3:34 (NIV)

For the one whom God has sent speaks the words of God, for God gives the **Spirit** without limit.

John 6:63 (NIV)

The **Spirit** gives life; the flesh counts for nothing. The words I have spoken to you are **spirit** and they are life.

John 7:39 (NIV)

By this he meant the **Spirit**, whom those who believed in him were later to receive. Up to that time the **Spirit** had not been given, since Jesus had not yet been glorified.

John 14:17 (NIV)

the **Spirit** of truth. The world cannot accept him, because it neither sees him nor knows him. But you know him, for he lives with you and will be in you.

John 14:26 (NIV)

But the Counselor, the Holy **Spirit**, whom the Father will send in my name, will teach you all things and will remind you of everything I have said to you.

John 15:26 (NIV)

"When the Counselor comes, whom I will send to you from the Father, the **Spirit** of truth who goes out from the Father, he will testify about me.

John 16:13 (NIV)

But when he, the **Spirit** of truth, comes, he will guide you into all truth. He will not speak on his own; he will speak only what he hears, and he will tell you what is yet to come.

John 16:15 (NIV)

All that belongs to the Father is mine. That is why I said the **Spirit** will take from what is mine and make it known to you.

John 20:22 (NIV)

And with that he breathed on them and said, "Receive the Holy **Spirit**."
